- Centennial, Pallesen and Namiyi have showers for emergencies only.
- Residential sites have full kitchen supplies including coffee maker, toaster, and kettle. However, leaders are encouraged to bring cleaning supplies and any specialized equipment required for food preparation. Campers are required to bring their own sleeping bags.
- Tenting sites have coffee maker, kettle and toaster but only *basic* cooking pots and utensils. Leaders should bring their own food preparation and cleaning supplies and tents. Campers are required to bring their own mess kits and sleeping bags.
- There are 2 BBQ's for shared use in the BBQ shelter behind Centennial. Play items are available in the BBQ shelter. Please return after use.
- At the south end of the property, there is a lagoon and a small amphitheatre with benches and a lectern.
- On the bench above Pallesen house, there is a "Team Adventure park" to be shared by all campers.

- Water carriers, wagon, an axe, mops, brooms, buckets, washing bowls and basic pots are supplied at all sites, except Heritage. Leaders should bring cleaning supplies and any special equipment they need for food preparation. Campers must bring their own mess kits.
- Drinking water can be obtained by starting the generator in the pumphouse behind Chickadee. A hand pump behind Lodge is Not Potable. Some prefer to bring their own drinking water.
- Fridge space is limited. Propane fridges have been unreliable during the winter camping season. Please have a back up plan!
- Some play items are available in the storage closet in Office. Please return them after use.
- There is a small amphitheatre near the road to Whiskeyjack.
