Basic program fee (including transportation)	\$125	\$170

- *Groups can expect an additional fee for audiences over 35: **\$2.00 per person**
- *Groups larger than 40 will be considered
- Animal related non-profit groups are eligible for a discount fee of \$100 (e.g. Humane societies)
- Organizations requesting an education animal are limited to a maximum of 3 programs per day. Clients should be aware that education animals may be cancelled at the last minute due to weather conditions and health considerations
- Requests for programs outside Zones 1 and 2 are considered on an individual case basis
- Some programs may be delivered without an Education animal, upon request, but the fee remains the same

Fees for On-Site Programs[±]

(Maximum 35 people per session or overlapping programs for larger groups may be arranged)
Due to the size of the classroom and the certainty that there will be injured and stressed animals on site the group size is limited.

Center Tour & Presentation	\$100 plus \$1/tour participant
Presentation only	\$100

[±]Note: Most on-site presentations are one hour in length. Tours take one half to one hour more, depending on the size of the group and time of year. Overlapping Presentations/Tours may be arranged depending on the size of the group.
