The Cross Conservation Area is a 4800 acres nature preserve located 1.5 km SW of the Calgary city limits off of highway 22X. Our programs offer youth groups the opportunity to learn about nature appreciation and conservation. These self-guided programs will prepare leaders to guide their group in an interpretive hike full of nature discovery activities.

Rescue the Fescue

- Interactive ecology based program
- Explores the roles and adaptations of wildlife and plant life in the grassland
- Fescue Trail (4.8 km or 4-5 hrs)

- Activity based program
- Focuses on the Aspen Parkland community, the inhabitants and their interactions
- Chevron Aspen Trail (3.6 km or 3-4 hrs)
