Accountability

Responsibilities

- To be conversant with Guiding, its Vision, Mission, and Principles as well as its programs.
- Encourage the involvement and active participation of guiding members 18 to 30 years of age through Link membership and activities.
- Increase the awareness of Link and encourage and support Link activities.
- Encourage Link members to apply for provincial, national, and international events.
- Encourage Link members to participate in trainings.
- Liaise between the Link members and Calgary Area Council.
- Organize and promote Link events through a Link email account and mailing list.
- Process all correspondence, including communication with the Calgary Guide Centre, Area Commissioner, Provincial Link Liaison, National Link Adviser, and other Area Link Presidents.
- Ensure that activities carried out by Link in Calgary Area are consistent with the policies of Girl Guides of Canada.
- Make recommendations to Calgary Area Council, on behalf of Link members.
- Solicit, approve, and submit Link articles and events to ENews and the Link Facebook group.
- Maintain relationships with other members, staff, other committees/teams, and Area Council.

Expectations to Area Council

- To submit regular reports to the Calgary Area Membership Committee.
- To submit an annual report to the Calgary Area Membership Adviser by the required date.
- To attend Area Council meetings by invitation and to report as required.
- To participate in TEAM (Training and Enrichment of Adult Members).

Qualifications

- A commitment to and passion for GGC.
- Has a passion to increase and encourage the membership of Link within Alberta Council.
